ACCOMMODATION SERVICES

The students at our university have no problems regarding accommodation. Having a capacity of 2500 people and located in Ahmet Necdet Sezer Campus, Üniyurt Private Student Dormitories provides accommodation opportunities for our students in the campus. In pursuance of "Easement Agreement" signed between Afyon Kocatepe University and Private Univert Higher Education Student (both for female and male) Dormitories, accommodation scholarship is provided for our successful students who need this scholarship.

There is a dormitory of the Credit and Dormitories Institution adjacent to the Ahmet Necdet Sezer Campus with a total capacity of 6000 students. Many private dormitories in the province of Afvonkarahisar also meet the accommodation needs of students. Moreover, there are private dormitories in the districts of Afvonkarahisar. Apart from the accommodation in the dormitories, students can easily find and rent homes in appropriate conditions.

CATERING

Economic and high quality food is served to the students and staff in our campuses; food scholarship is provided for our successful students who need this scholarship. Varying according to the seasons and the required calories and nutritional needs of the students, meals are prepared under hygienic conditions by a private company and under the supervision of food engineers.

As per the "Direction of Lunch Grant, Scholarship, and Accommodation Aid" numbered 2012/79, "Lunch Grant" is provided for 450 students every year with the decision of the Board.

HEALTH SERVICES

The first places where students of our university consult when they have any health problems are the nearest health centers. Also, the Medico-Social Centre operated in our university provides services for protecting the physical and mental health of both our students and staff.

CULTURAL FACILITIES

We organize various and numerous art, social, and cultural events throughout the year for our students to make the best use of their free time. In our university, we aim to educate qualified individuals. Therefore, we used conference halls and multi-purpose rooms (the Atatürk Congress Centre, the İbrahim Küçükkurt Conference Hall, and multi-purpose rooms in the academic departments). These rooms are well equipped to meet the requirements of any cultural and art events of students and academicians.

LIBRARY

The library and documentation services are indispensable sources for qualified scientific research at all levels of education. The Central Library provides services for students and academicians for the purpose of being a model information centre meeting the demands of information services at the highest level, offering services required in the Modern Era in its best way, and making a significant contribution to development of the university. It has group work rooms and individual study sections, and the books are organized by an open shelves system. With the sophisticated Library Automation System, its sources can be searched online. Moreover, the users can quickly benefit from the library services through the self-check (automatic borrow-return) machines. In the Central Library, we have over 162,000 printed publications, journals, and periodicals. In addition to these, there are also 31 Electronic Databases provided by TUBITAK-ULAKBIM. In the content of the databases, there are 4.418.704 e-books, 40.996 electronic journals, and 4.840.867 electronic dissertations. Our study hall at the library is open for 7 days/24 hours and it has the capacity of 84 people. In addition to adding new books, journals, and scientific documents within modern standards to the library, there is always an increase in the possibilities of lending sources and accessing online and using the information at the domestic and foreign libraries and the information centres.

SPORTS ACTIVITIES


Sports activities are organized in our university in order to contribute to students' physical. mental, and cognitive development and to provide opportunities for their socialization. All campuses have sports facilities offering students opportunities for doing sports, and young sportsmen can do sports in the university teams. The sports teams formed by our students represent us in inter-university competitions successfully in football, basketball, volleyball, handball, tennis, table tennis, badminton, wrestling, athletics, American football, and cross-country running teams. At the university, there are one semi-olympic swimming pool, two sports halls, one gymnastics hall, two fitness halls, two dance halls, one standard size football pitch, one indoor astro pitch, one indoor tennis court, two outdoor tennis courts, one beach volleyball pitch, one outdoor basketball pitch, one beach handball pitch, one synthetic grass pitch (football), one athletics track, one table tennis room, and two multi-purpose halls (fencing, archery, shooting, taekwondo, karate, judo, and massage halls).

STUDENT MOBILITY

We have agreements with 82 universities within the scope of Farabi Exchange Program, 176 universities in 38 different countries within the Erasmus Exchange Program, and 26 universities in 19 different countries within the Meylana Exchange Program. Moreover, our university offers double majors in 46 departments and minors in 67 departments.

INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

Our university carries out Erasmus+ and Mevlana Exchange programs successfully in the context of international relations. Within the scope of Erasmus+ program, bilateral agreements have been signed with almost all of the European Union member countries for student and staff exchange. Within the scope of Mevlana Exchange program, agreements have been signed with a great number of universities from a variety of countries. These are especially Central Asian countries, Pakistan, Jordan, Lebanon, Japan, and so on. Under these agreements, our students have the opportunity to have education for one semester or two semesters at the partner universities. Our university has become a member of two different Internship Consortiums in 2015. Through these consortiums, we have been sending several students for internship to different European Countries since 2016.

Moreover, our university has welcomed great number foreign students since 2012-2013 academic years. In this scope, 200 students have come from 30 countries to our university. Today, this number is about 700, and the number of the foreign students studying in our university increases every year.
